COURT SUPERVISION – MARION COUNTY


WHEREAS, in February of 2020, the Conference of Chief Circuit Judges designated Marion County as a county authorized to enter orders of supervision under Section 5-6-3.1 of the Unified Code of Corrections (730 ILCS 5/5-6-3.1) for traffic offenses satisfied pursuant to Paragraph (a) of Supreme Court Rule 529; and

WHEREAS, Lake Land College offers a traffic safety program under standards set by the Conference; and

WHEREAS, a traffic safety program by which the accused attends and successfully completes such program best serves the public and is in the best interests of justice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Circuit Court of the Fourth Judicial Circuit, Marion County, Illinois is authorized to enter orders of supervision in accordance with Supreme Court Rules which include a program by which the accused, upon payment of the fine, penalties and costs provided by law, agrees to attend and successfully complete the traffic safety program conducted by Lake Land College in Mattoon, Illinois.
